1. What does Paul mean by “whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly”?
2. According to verse 7, what matters more than the amount we give?
3. How does this passage challenge the way we think about possessions?
4. What promises does God make to those who are generous? Are these promises material or spiritual?
5. How does generosity lead others to glorify God?
6. What does this passage teach us about where our “treasure” really is?
7. What practical steps can help us “watch our treasure” in daily life?
8. Why does Paul end this section by thanking God for His “indefinable gift”?

February 8- Watching Your Time

Ephesians 5:16

Colossians 4:5

1. What does it mean to make the most of every opportunity?
2. Why does Paul connect time management with the phrase “because the days are evil”? (Eph. 5:16)
3. According to Colossians 4:5, how does our use of time affect our witness to others?
4. What are some common ways people unintentionally waste time today?
5. How can “walking in wisdom” guide the way we schedule our days?
6. What is the difference between being busy and being purposeful?
7. What practical steps can help believers better steward their time?
8. What is one area of your life where God may be asking you to be more intentional with your time?

4. Why do you think Joshua says, “As for me and my house” instead of only speaking for himself?
5. What are some “foreign gods” that can subtly influence homes today?
6. How can families actively serve the Lord in everyday home life?
7. What challenges make it difficult to keep a Christ-centered home?
8. What is one step you can take this week to help your home better serve the Lord?
